Annual Report 2019/2020

At the AGM last year, I highlighted 2 key priorities: to work closer with the school to collaborate on deeply meaningful and purposeful projects and to create a greater awareness of the Alumni association amongst the students such that we can have a steady stream of new members. To create the requisite capacity for these priorities, we have scaled down on our smaller activities and rode on NUS and other sister alumni related activities for our members to participate in. The number of activities have also been reduced due to the Covid-19 outbreak in the later part of the year. That said, we continued to successfully organize our signature events such as the NUS Business School Golf Reunion Challenge 2019 at Orchid Country Club, jointly organized the Explore Singapore as well as the *Oktoberfest* networking event with BIZAlum (previously known as GANO).

I would also like to thank Abhinav and Clodimir for rejuvenating our monthly drinks, which has grown in attendance. We have also started to revamp our MBA website and I would like to thank Tim, Eddy, Nari and our new secretariat Sophie for driving this initiative.

Financially, we are healthy. We need to be good stewards of our finances but we will continually be on the lookout for worthwhile initiatives to invest our resources in.

It has been a privilege serving on the board of the MBA Alumni for the past 10 years, and as the President for the past 2 years. I would like to thank my strong core exco team, who has been relentless. Without their passion and drive, we would not have achieved any of these outcomes in the past years. I would also like to thank board members, alumni members, BIZAlum, the NUS Business School and many others for their strong support. It is time for me to move on and hand over the reins to a younger and more dynamic team. Therefore, I have decided not to stand for board election for 2020/21. I hope that you can continue to give your strong support, endorsement and encouragement to the new President and his team, as you had given to me and my team for the past 2 years.
